South Orange, New Jersey.

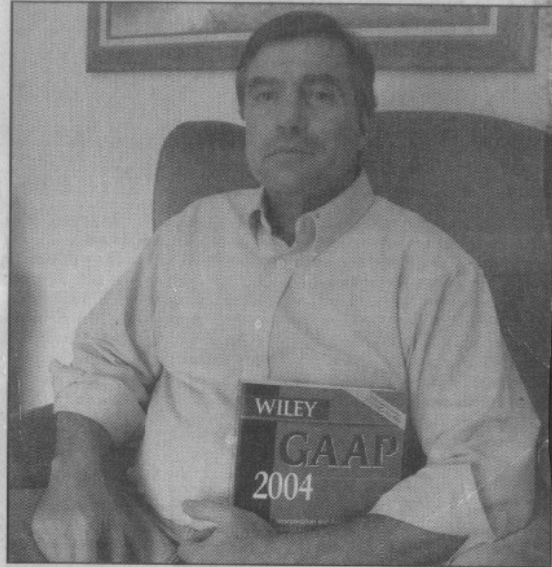
